Support for Churches

In-Care Notification: As soon as your BA congregation takes someone In-Care, regardless of the person's status with Committee on Ministry -- Section A, please contact the BA In-Care Liaison. MIT Grants: If your congregation has, or hopes to have, a Minister-in-Training (MIT), we offer grants. Your congregation should have received a letter from us in mid-February indicating application should be sent to BA Moderator. If you've not applied yet, set application to the BA Grants Coordinator.

Support for Local In-Care Persons

Persons In-Care with a Bay Association church, regardless of where there are in the process with Committee on Ministry -- Section A, qualify for our support. In-Care Email List: To receive messages from the In-Care Liaison, sent about every 2-3 months often to announce BA events, please contact the BA In-Care Liaison.
