Youth and Young Adult Grants Policy

The Bay Association Executive Council has defined guidelines and procedures for the use of funds allocated for Youth and Young Adult Scholarships. This policy describes the types of grants awarded and how to apply for them. Grants will be awarded based upon availability of funds and number of applications. Decisions of the Bay Association Executive Council are final.

Eligibility and Availability

Grants are available for persons under the age of thirty who need financial assistance to take part in Bay Association, Conference, or UCC national events (excluding Conference camping events that are covered by the Conference Campership program).

Applicants (or their parents if the applicant is under the age of 18) must be members of a Bay Association congregation. An individual may receive one grant per calendar year.

Grants will not exceed \$250 or one-third of the estimated expense to take part in the event.

Grants are awarded on a first response basis. The total amount available in any calendar year will be determined by the Association.

Notification

The Corresponding Secretary will send an annual notification to all Authorized Ministers as well as the moderator and youth leaders of all Local Churches in the Bay Association. Note: The Corresponding Secretary will make a reasonable effort to identify all individuals who should receive the notification.
